

REQUIREMENTS FOR RENEWAL OF LICENSE

Section 601 - Licensees must continue professional practices including:

- a. Updating and distributing copies of their code of professional ethics to their clients; and
- b. Updating and distributing copies of their informed consent forms and requiring all clients to sign and date an informed consent form prior to receiving any neurofeedback; and
- c. Maintaining signed copies of informed consent forms in their client files for at least seven years after termination of neurotherapy services; and
- d. Continuing to practice the professional conduct described in Section 207 of these regulations; and
- e. Continuing to guarantee client safety by following the standards set forth in Section 109 of these regulations.

Section 602 - Licensees must continue their neurotherapy education:

- a. To renew their neurotherapy license, licensees must complete twenty clock hours of instruction through classroom, Internet or correspondence courses, workshops, seminars, conferences or individual instruction; and
- b. The instruction described and required in Section 602a must be in animal anatomy or biology, biofeedback, neurotherapy equipment, neurotherapy protocols, clinical skills, coaching, ethics, energy healing, energy medicine, human anatomy, biology or physiology, neurotherapy, professional conduct, relaxation, visualization or any condition, disease or disorder for which neurotherapy may be a viable intervention; and
- c. Of the twenty-hour requirement, up to ten hours may be earned for instructing or supervising one or more neurotherapy technicians for a minimum of twenty-clock hours; or
- d. The ten hour option described in Section 602c of these regulations may be satisfied by instructing groups of neurofeedback professionals for a minimum of twenty hours; or
- e. The ten hour option described in Section 602c of these regulations may be satisfied by courses, workshops, seminars and conferences used to satisfy licensing renewal requirements for any other health care license; or
- f. The ten hour option described in Section 602c of these regulations may be satisfied by any courses, workshops, seminars and conferences taken to improve licensee's business practices and skills.
